To cement the very high standard grade I think more contributors are essential and to consider how you will present your contributors. You've done an excellent job of picking out Georgia's best comments and this has resulted in lots of jump cuts that should be masked with a cutaway. Consider less juxtaposition in the edit too, for example the shot where Georgia's friends arrive is little too obvious when coupled with her voiceover.
